#### Intake Checklist

Upon intake your pet has presented with the following issues:

\_\_\_\_\_Excessive eye discharge build up. Once this is removed the area under this may be red, irritated, swollen, sore and possibly bleeding.

\_\_\_\_\_Excessive matting.

\_\_\_\_\_Groin matting. Once this matting is removed it may expose redness, irritation and chewed areas.

\_\_\_\_\_Excessive feces on the body (location)\_\_\_\_\_. Once this is removed this area may be red, irritated, swollen and sore.

\_\_\_\_\_Ear issues. There is an irritation caused by an infection or other issue in the \_\_\_left, \_\_\_\_right, \_\_\_both ears. \*\*\*SALON NAME\*\*\* \_\_\_\_will \_\_\_\_will not be cleaning out the ears. We advise a visit to the veterinarian to treat the issue.
